This is an open category event; prepare sample sizes of your best apple-infused recipe (anything from BBQ to baked goods!) and compete for one of two Golden Tickets and the chance to represent Nebraska at the 2021 World Food Championship in Dallas, Texas (*see back for more details about the World Food Championships). Chefs and home cooks welcome.

The 2020 Taste of AppleJack “All Things Apple” Recipe Contest will be held on Sunday, October 4, from 11 a.m. until 3 p.m. at the Historic Barns at Arbor Day Farm in Nebraska City as part of Nebraska City’s month-long AppleJack Harvest Festival. Space is limited; only 20 contestants will be allowed to enter.

CONTEST RULES:

1. Entry must be apple-based/apple-infused.
2. Prepare small samples/tastings for 150 people. There are no kitchen or prep facilities onsite.
3. You may bring extra packaged products to sell (only of what you are entering in the contest).
4. Be set up and ready to serve by 10:45 a.m. Doors will open promptly at 11 a.m.
5. Judging closes at 2:45 p.m. Winners announced at 3 p.m.
